Printed/Bound Publications of NBTS Seminarians

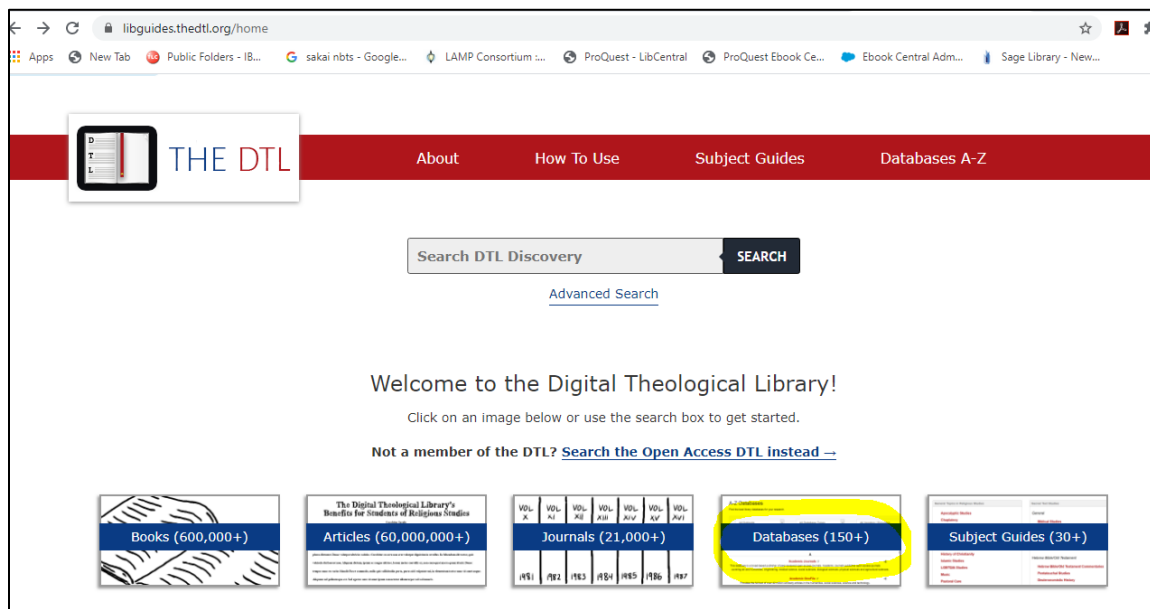
Most dissertations published in 2018 or earlier are only available in print format. To find these works search the [Sage Library catalog](#) by title or author. Not all dissertations and theses are currently indexed. Print materials may not be checked out and are only available for in-library use. Digital Copies of Publications by NBTS Seminarians

Recent dissertations published in 2019 or later can be accessed remotely using ProQuest Dissertations & Theses Global database. Finding Dissertations in the Digital Theological Library

1. Navigate to the [Digital Theological Library](#) and select “Databases.”



2. In the search bar enter in “ProQuest Dissertations & Theses” and click “Go.”





5. In the Advanced Search screen enter in your search options.
